Covid Safety Protocols For In Person Services

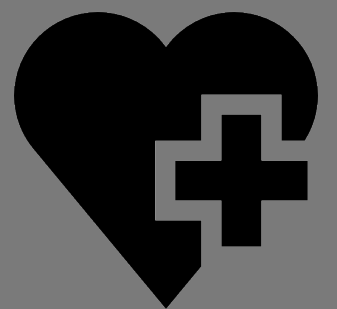
Cleaning



- The building will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before services
- Surfaces and high touch areas will be disinfected and wiped down throughout the morning
- Fabric chairs used in auditorium will be disinfected before and after each service

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the building
- Masks will not be required; however, they are welcome and encouraged for anyone who feels more comfortable with them. Free masks are available for anyone who needs one
- Door greeters will be there to minimize touched surfaces and inside doors will be propped open where possible
- To allow for social distancing, there will be a capacity for how many people can be in the auditorium. Once we have reached that limit there will be an option to sit in areas in the lobby where you can watch the service on the TVs. Once those areas are full we may need to ask you to attend a different service
- If you are sick or showing any flu-like symptoms, please stay home and join us online
